

DR. CHRIS KOENIG-WOODYARD is an award-winning teacher, who read the Master of Studies and the Doctor of Philosophy at Oxford University. A former Doctoral Fellow (Oxford University) and Post-Doctoral Fellow (University of Toronto) of the Social Sciences and Humanities Council of Canada, he teaches at the University of Toronto, and has taught and lectured at Oxford, the University of Western Ontario, Trent University, the University of Guelph, Morgan State University (Baltimore, Maryland), and Wilfrid Laurier University. He is co-editor of *Transatlantic Romanticism: An Anthology of American, British, and Canadian Literature, 1767-1867* (Longman, 2006); "*Sullen Fires across the Atlantic*": *Essays in British and American Romanticism*. (Romantic Circles); and *Romantic Poetry in America: A Bibliography* (forthcoming). He is a contributing editor to *The Broadview Anthology of British Literature: Concise Volume B*; and is managing editor of the *Jackson Bibliography of Romantic Poetry* (<http://jacksonbibliography.library.utoronto.ca>). His work has appeared in *The Wordsworth Circle* and *Romanticism and Victorianism on the Net*. In 2006, he was a recipient of an Undergraduate Teaching Award, Students' Administrative Council-Association of Part-Time Undergraduate Studies, University of Toronto.
